CARDBOARD BOAT RACE JUDGE'S GOALS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

While the Cardboard Boat Race Judges need to ensure that participants are following the race and boat construction guidelines, during the course of the event we also hope that you help Hudson Crossing Park:

- * RAISE AWARENESS OF HUDSON CROSSING PARK & OUR MISSION
- * FOSTER COMMUNITY SPIRIT
- * ENCOURAGE OUTDOOR PLAY & ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY
- * RAISE MONEY TO HELP SUPPORT THE PARK'S VOLUNTEER EFFORTS

Judge Responsibilities:

- Boats must abide by the Cardboard Boat Race Rules & Regulations.
- Winners of each race are at the judges' sole discretion.
- "People's Choice" winners will be chosen by ballot: \$1 per vote. The winning boat will receive 50% of the ballot donations as prize.
- The "Judges Bribe" is purely a donation to Hudson Crossing Park. Anyone may bribe you on behalf of their favorite boat. Please keep a running tally of your highest bribe of the day. If someone bribes you with \$20, the next person must pay \$21 to be in the lead. Bribes are cumulative – the \$20 "briber" may then give you \$2 to be back in the lead. Depending on the number of bribes each judge may EACH award one winner OR you may choose to award one winner overall.
- Winning boats MUST pass through the finish line.
