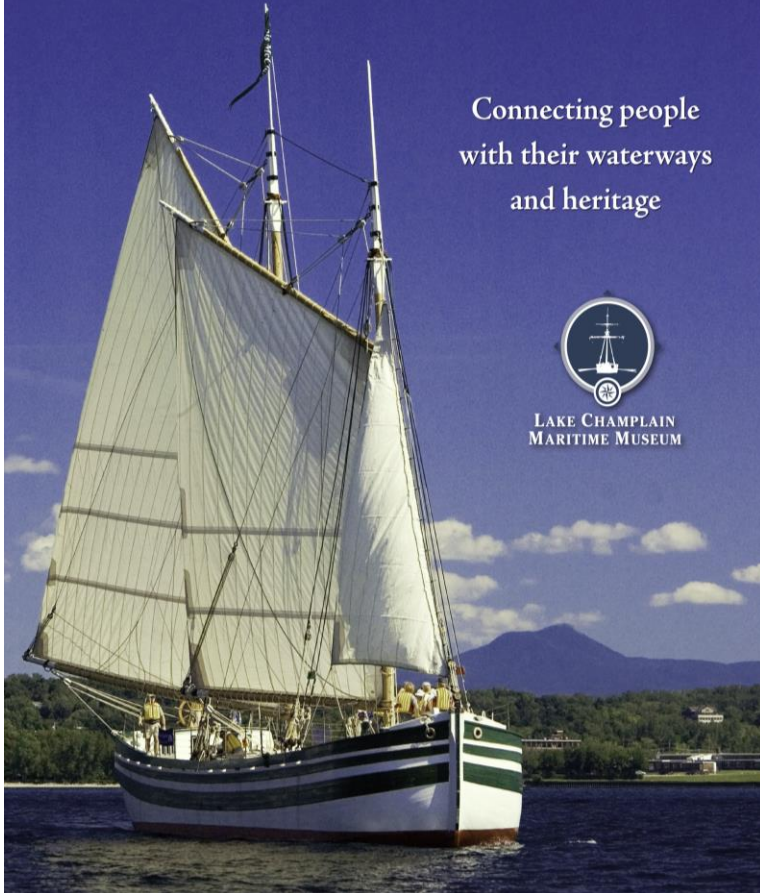

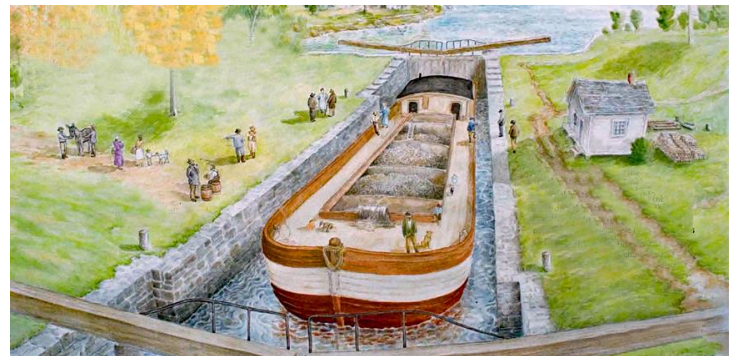

**Celebrating the Bicentennial  
of the Erie Canal**



The schooner Lois McClure is just another canal boat in the canal but it becomes a sail boat on Lake Champlain.

This voyage celebrates the huge undertaking that began on July 4, 1817 in Rome, NY, when ground was broken for the construction of the Erie Canal. By its opening in 1825, the new navigable waterway included 18 aqueducts to carry the canal over ravines and rivers, and 83 locks, with a rise of 568 feet from the Hudson River to Lake Erie.
